Kit Content

The CY8CKIT-059 PSoC 5LP Prototyping Kit includes the following items:

- CY8CKIT-059 PSoC 5LP prototyping board
- Quick start guide

Software and Tools

The code examples shipped with this kit require PSoC Creator™ 3.1 or later. This is available with the kit installer or on the PSoC Creator web page (www.cypress.com/go/psoccreator). PSoC Creator also installs the PSoC Programmer software, which is used to program PSoC devices.

Programming of the target PSoC 5LP device on the CY8CKIT-059 requires PSoC Programmer 3.22.2 and KitProg 2.11.
