Limitations:

- This kit cannot be used in self-powered mode.
- The High Speed USB OTG functionality of EZ-USB® FX3™ cannot be tested in the kit.
- UART Hardware flow control is not supported in this kit.
- UART baud rate should not be more than 115200 while accessing JTAG interface through the USB-Serial IC (CY7C65125).

Known Issues:

- This kit is not designed to meet USB suspend-current requirements.
